COVID Updates

Diocese of Cheyenne Protocols as of March 2, 2022

On February 25, 2022, the CDC *issued new guidance regarding indoor masking*. Also, Governor Gordon announced that Wyoming's COVID-19 Public Health Emergency declaration is over, effective March 14.

Therefore, the COVID-19 Response Team recommends all COVID-19 protocols for the Diocese of Cheyenne be discontinued. Exceptions are that there will be no distribution of the Precious Blood, and the medical recommendation is to wear face coverings during distribution of Holy Communion and food service.

In addition, take precautions based on the COVID-19 Community Level in your area, which can be low, medium, or high.

WHAT TO DO IF YOU HAVE CONCERNS

Those who are vulnerable should take precautions to protect themselves by wearing KN-95 masks and maintaining distance from others. Those who are concerned about parish protocols should speak with their pastor.
